ABOUT THE PROGRAMME:

Students are required to attend two semesters of lectures in Greece.

- First Semester: September-November
- Second Semester: April-June
- Third Semester: September-February (thesis preparation).

- ✓ Bachelor degree holders from Greek and foreign Higher Educational Institutions

- Optional Modules (2 from below):
 - ✓ Olympic Movement and International relations
 - ✓ Sports high performance: Olympic athletes and dual careers
 - ✓ Strategic and operational planning of major sports events
 - ✓ Financial management of sports organizations
 - ✓ The role, organization and operation of Olympic museums and libraries.

3rd semester: Preparation, submission and presentation of Master's Thesis



COSTS AND FEES

Examination fees:

7,000 jpy for the first document screening

23,000 jpy for the second screening oral examination (~290 \$)

Admission fees: 282,000 jpy (non-refundable) (~2 708 \$)

Tuition: 535,800 jpy (annual) (~5 100 \$)

Scholarship: University of Tsukuba provided a scholarship of around 70,000 yen per month to eligible recipients in the TIAS 2.0 program.
